DALLAS MAKERSPACE MEMBERS COLLABORATE FOR FINE ART AND COUTURE FASHION OPENING

Dallas, TX, October 31, 2024 - It is with great excitement that Dallas Makerspace (DMS) announces a collaborative art and fashion opening. DMS members Kayleigh Ebenrick of [Prism & Pearl Fine Art](#), Faith Varghese, and Humera Khan of [HK&R Designs](#) have combined art and fashion with the technological tools available at Dallas Makerspace to create new and stunning works. Kayleigh's paintings combine spirituality, cubism, and impressionism. While up-and-coming fashion designers Faith & Humera combine their fashion skills to create fashion forward apparel with hand-painted and custom fabrics provided by the painter.

The creative trio utilize industrial sewing machines available in the Sewing Studio, with digital arts tools such as dye sublimation in Creative Arts, and fully utilize the safe 24hr access to the space for their design, construction and assembly of their high-end pieces and marketing elements.

The Creative Arts Studio in Dallas Makerspace is a space where local artists come together. DMS Creative Arts holds regular classes in Fine Arts: Watercolor, Calligraphy, Drawing, Airbrush and Oils including Bob Ross Certified Instructor, Joy of Painting classes, as well as leatherworking, resin casting, and fiber arts. Creative Arts also recently opened a 600 sqft studio dedicated to sewing, featuring a suite of industrial sewing machines, large work surfaces- and most importantly- a community of creative sewists.
